I ask that the Student Earned Income Exclusion be applied to my case as I meet the SSA criteria of being a “student child” as described on the Social Security Online website, at <http://www.ssa.gov/OACT/COLA/studentEIE.html>. The information provides that, “A blind or disabled child, who is a student regularly attending school, college, or university, or a course of vocational or technical training, can have limited earnings that are not counted against his or her Supplemental Security Income (SSI) benefits. The maximum amount of the income exclusion applicable to a student in 2012 is \$1,700 per month but not more than \$6,840 in 2012.”
